
# **ROAD SAFETY**

# ATTENDANCE

The attendance expectation set by OFSTED is 96%. Year 2 and Year 6 are the only classes to have met this so far this half term. Currently, our attendance is 95.6%. Please support us to improve this figure during December. 67 out of 270 pupils still have 100% attendance. Well done to them.

# <u>SPORT</u>

We have successfully taken part in a number of cluster sports events this term, including rugby, Boccia and gymnastics. Pupils demonstrated sports skills and positive attitudes at all events. Well done- we are very proud of you.

Year 2 and Year 5 have worked successfully with RuggerEds this term to develop their rugby skills, Year 3 children have had weekly sessions of 5/60 fitness with James, the coach from Bolsover District Council, whilst Year 4 and Year 6 have received basketball coaching.

Year 5 have completed their first term of swimming with the majority having received, Water Safety Award 1. Swimming will recommence on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

Running at 3 times per week during playtime has continued, with many children taking part and building their stamina and fitness levels. Some children have also aspired to run to the top of New Station Road without stopping! We are looking forward to putting our training into action at the Cross Country cluster event during the Spring term.

After Christmas, RuggerEds will be working in school to teach Rugby to Year 6 and Reception on Thursdays. These sessions will be outdoors so please make sure pupils have suitable outdoor PE kit.
