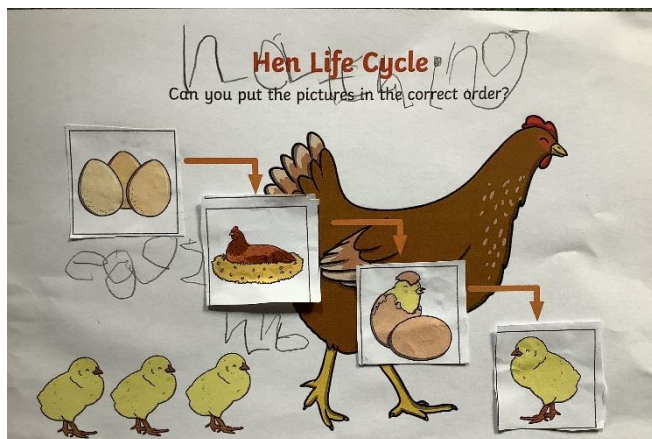


Welcome to this week's newsletter, which has been produced by... Nursery!
