

Exciting learning from around school!

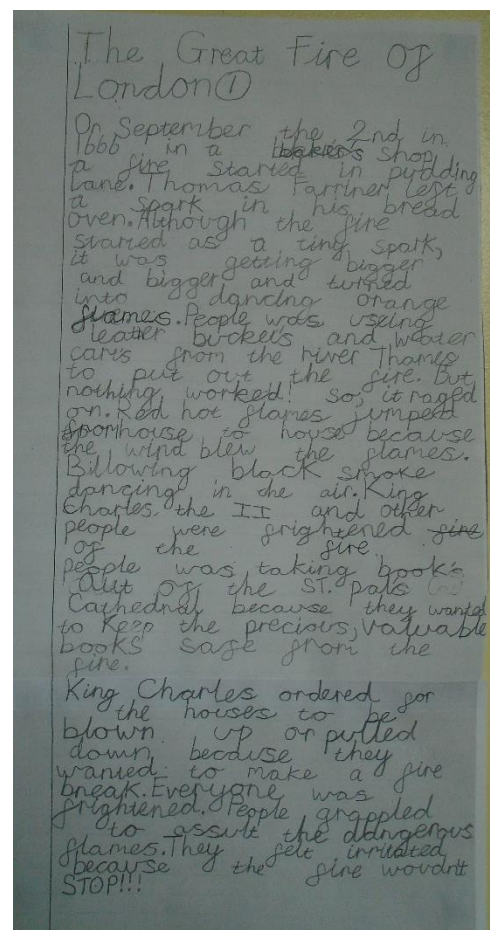


In Year 1 – In geography this term we have enjoyed being out in the school grounds finding signs of Spring and using a compass to locate areas of the school.

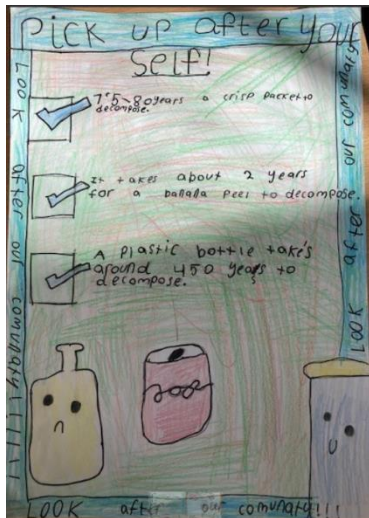
Things to look forward to in Year 2: Next term we are looking forward to learning about school in the Victorian era.

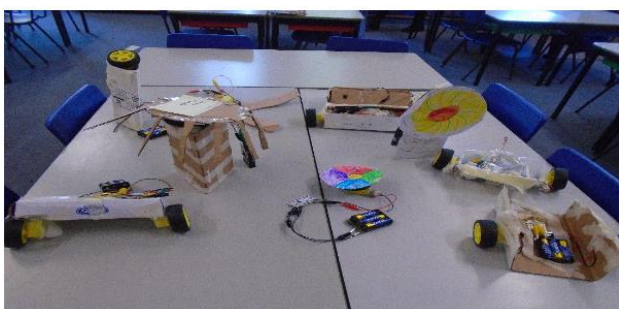
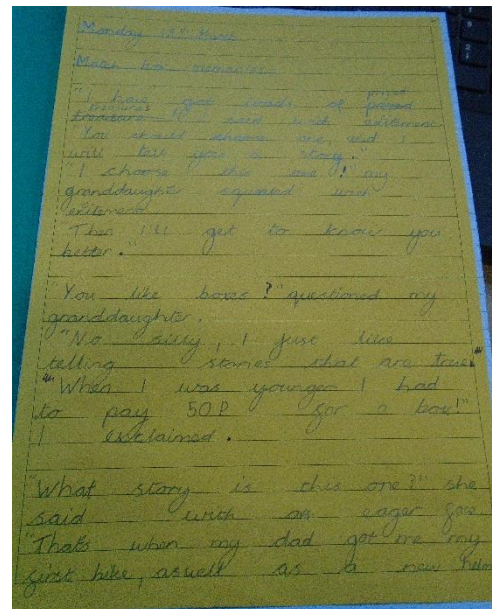
